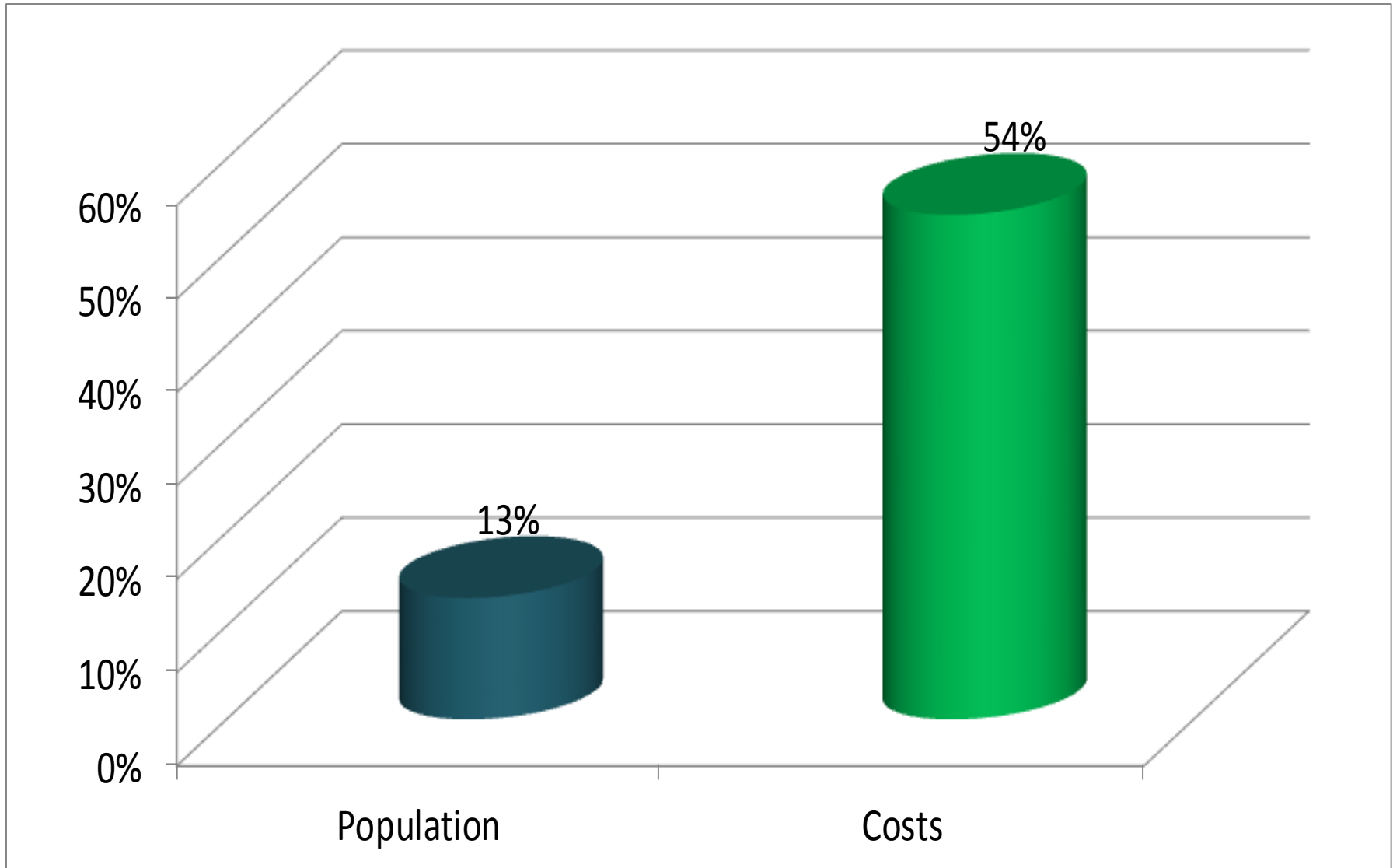

Health Takeaways:

- A smaller population have complex health issues and associated costs
- Issues related to heart disease and suicides are higher in rural counties than seen statewide
- Many factors impact health outcomes
- Those factors are interrelated
- They include:
 - A. Social Determinants of Health : housing, transportation, economy, community safety, education, access to health care, etc
 - B. Early childhood trauma
 - C. Personal behaviors – smoking, exercise, eating well, reduce stress

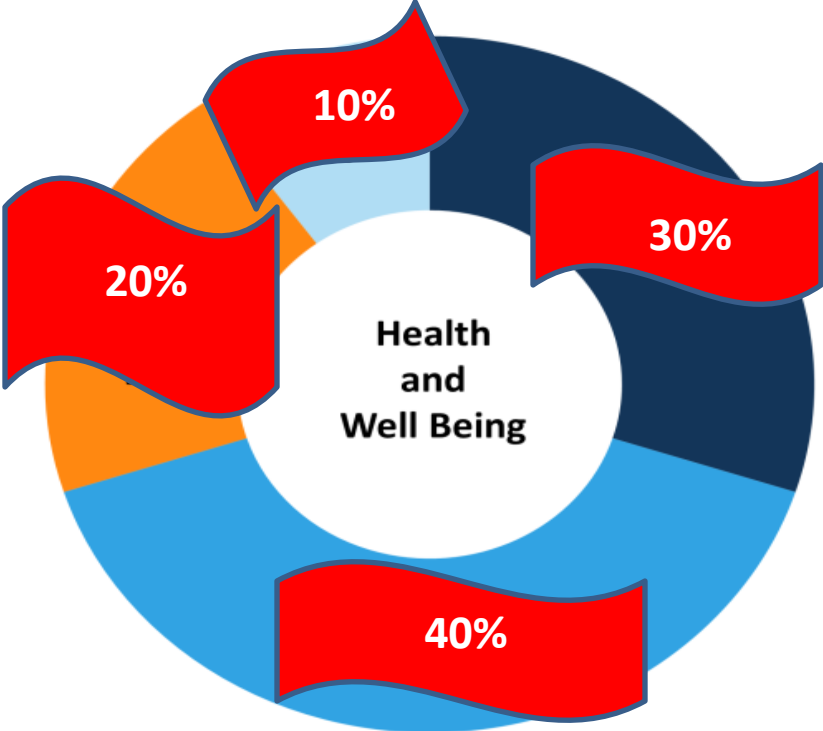

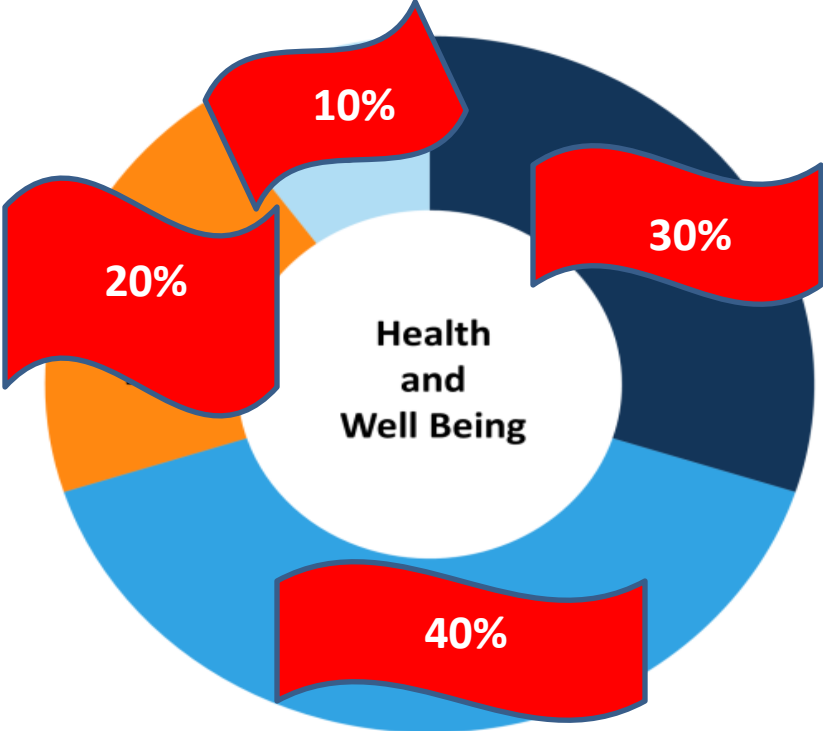
Impact of Different Factors on Risk of Premature Death

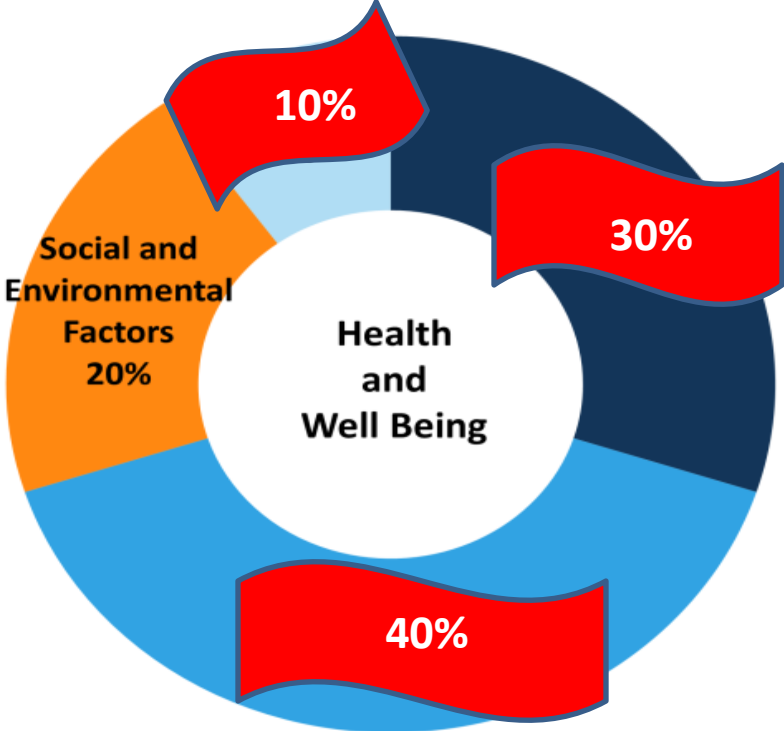
Impact of Different Factors on Risk of Premature Death

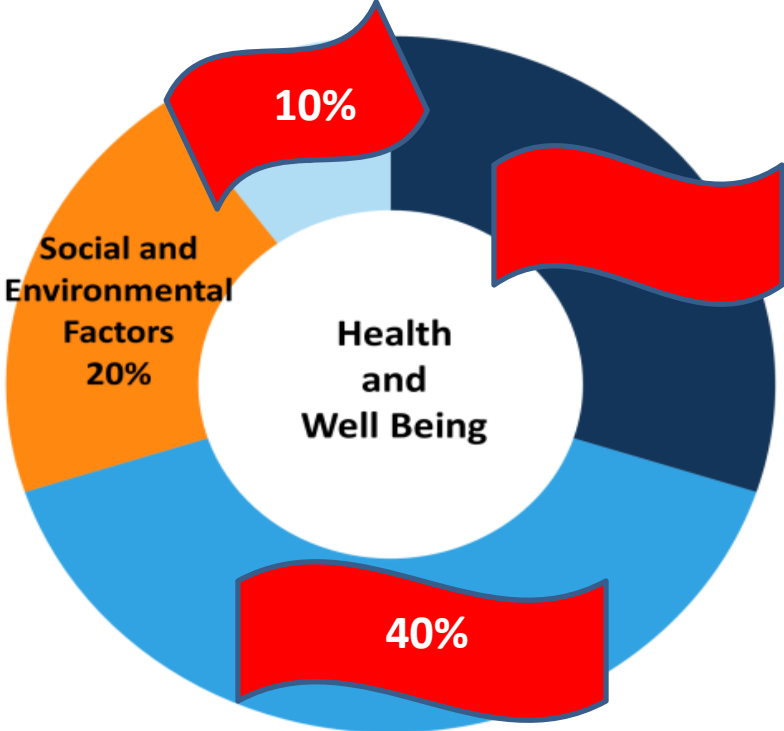
Impact of Different Factors on Risk of Premature Death

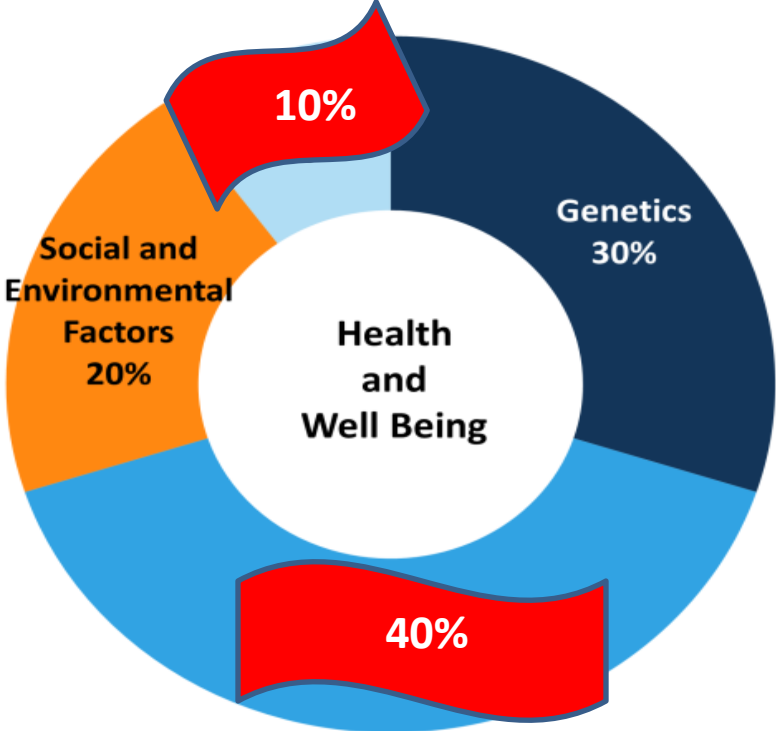
Impact of Different Factors on Risk of Premature Death

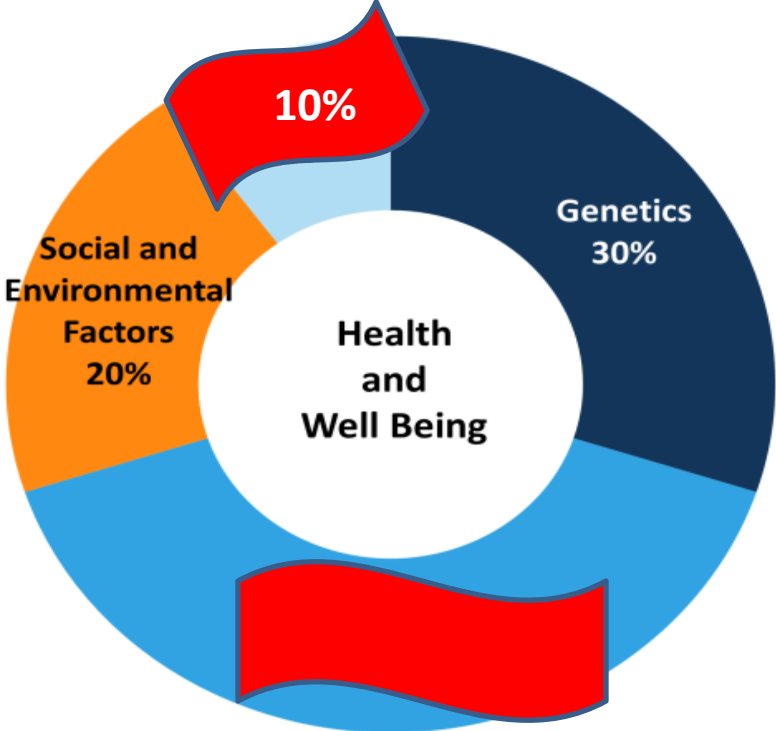
Impact of Different Factors on Risk of Premature Death

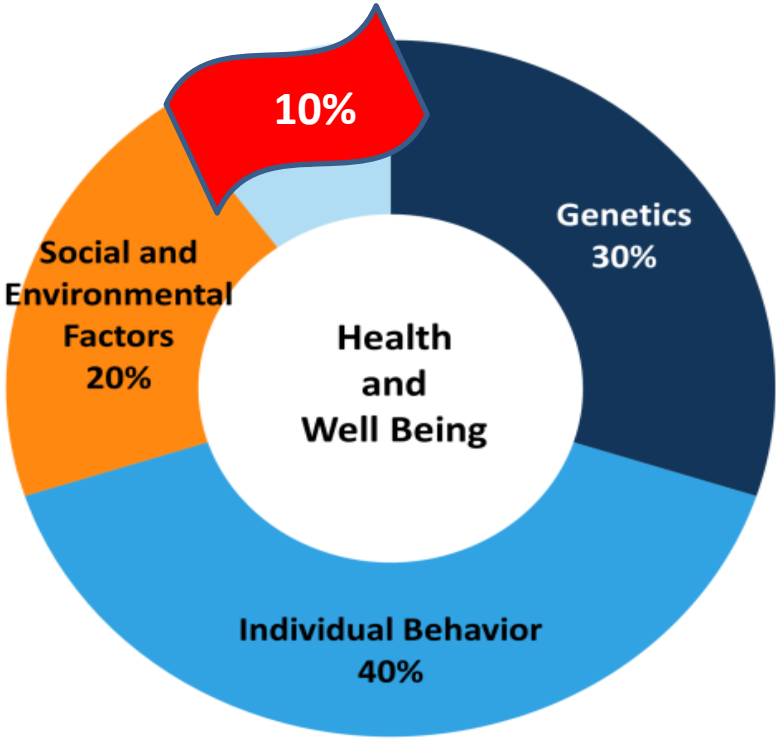
Impact of Different Factors on Risk of Premature Death

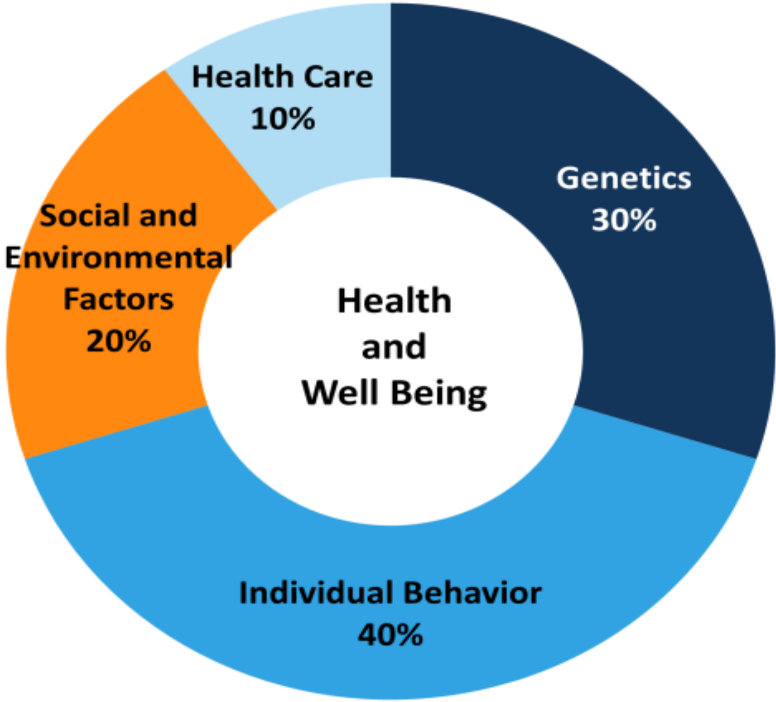
Impact of Different Factors on Risk of Premature Death

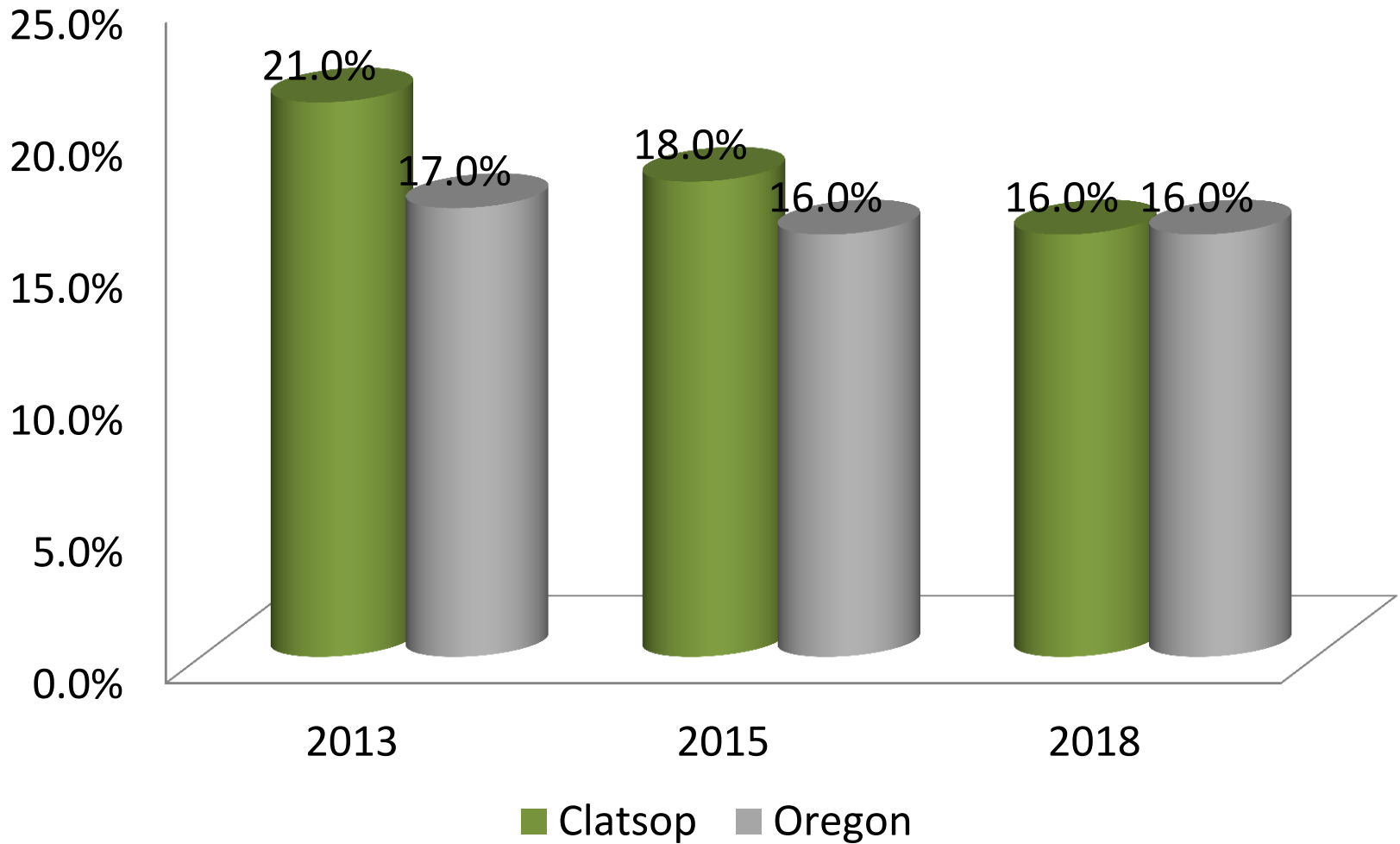

Impact of Different Factors on Risk of Premature Death

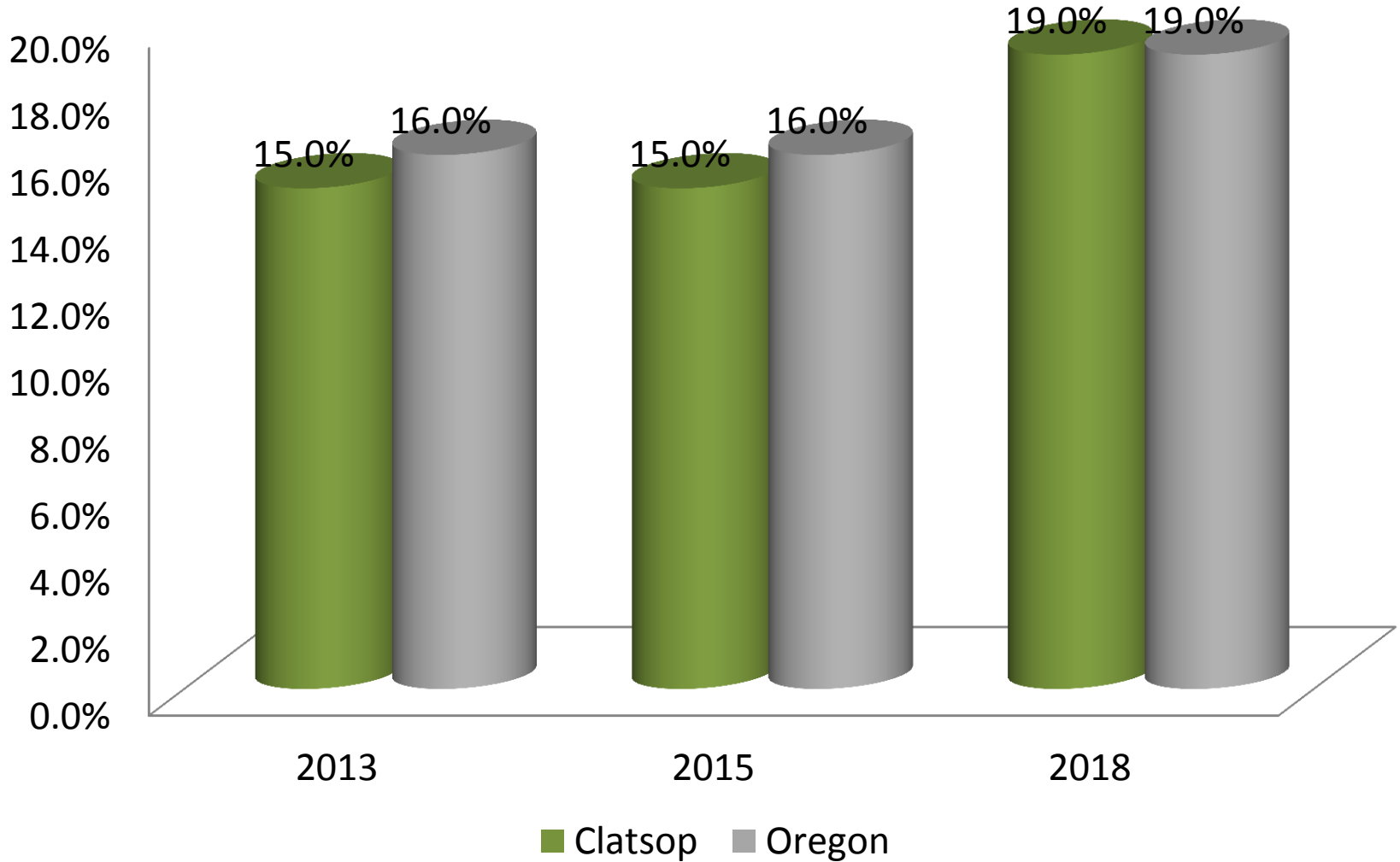

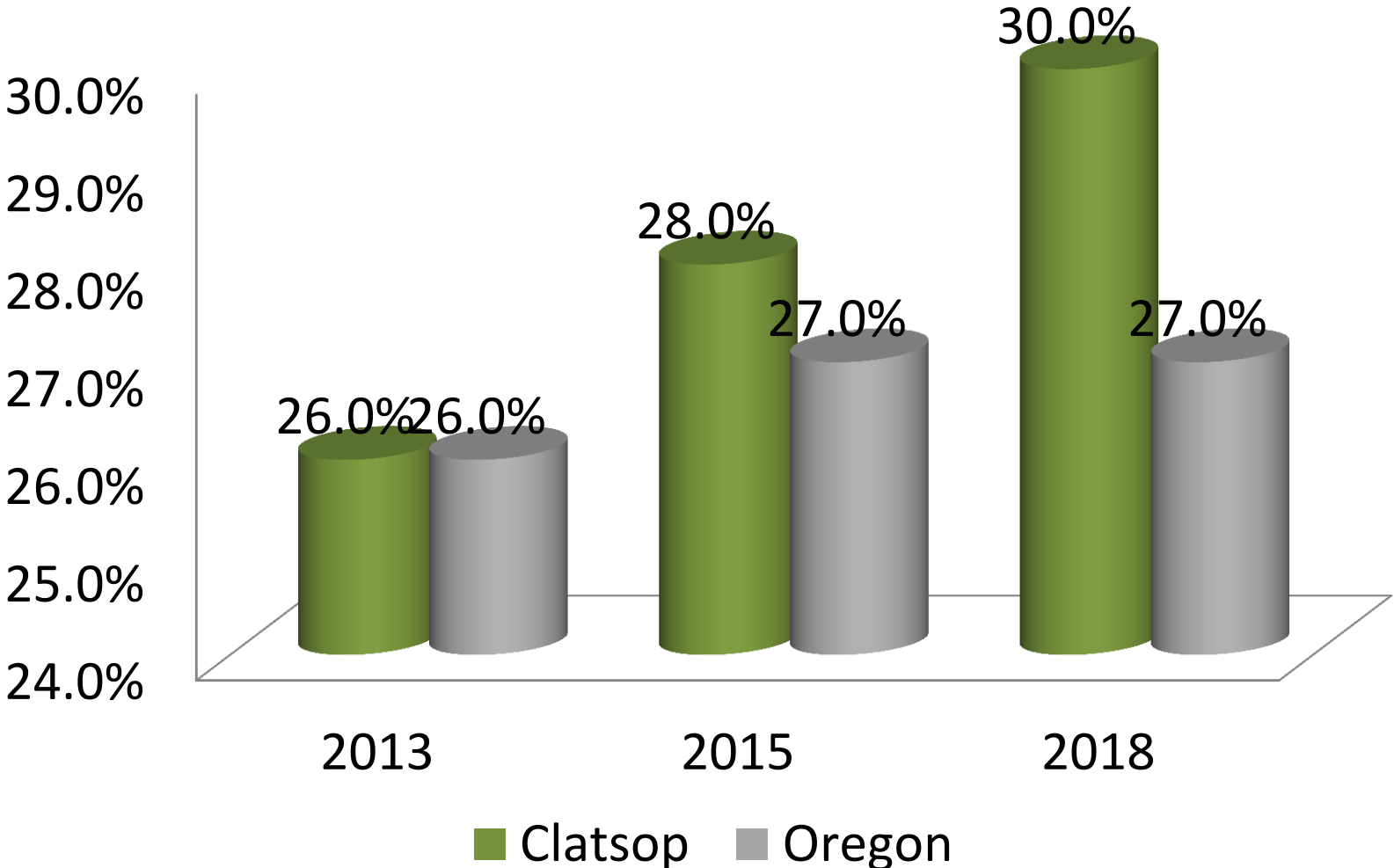

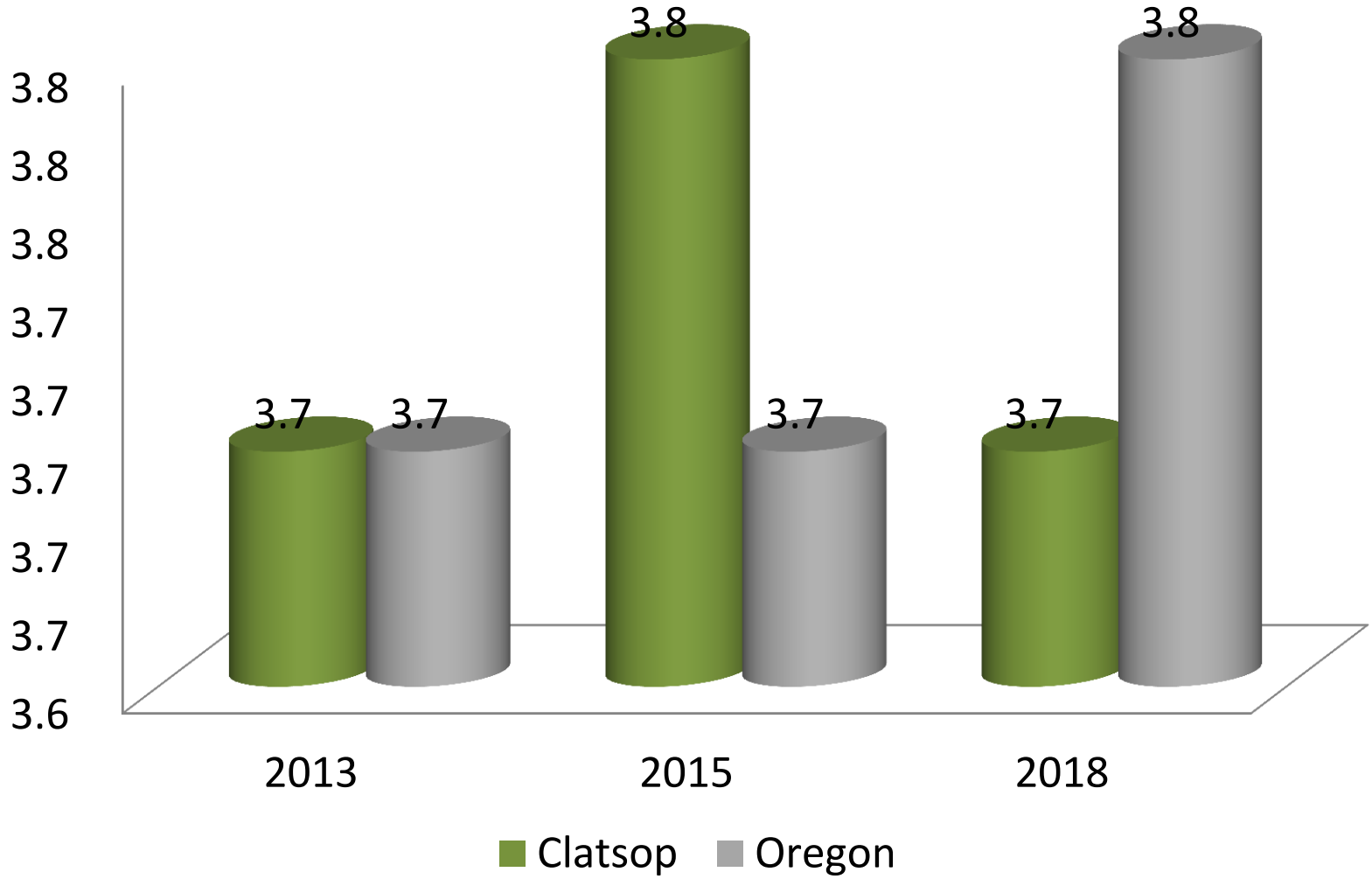
Excessive Drinking



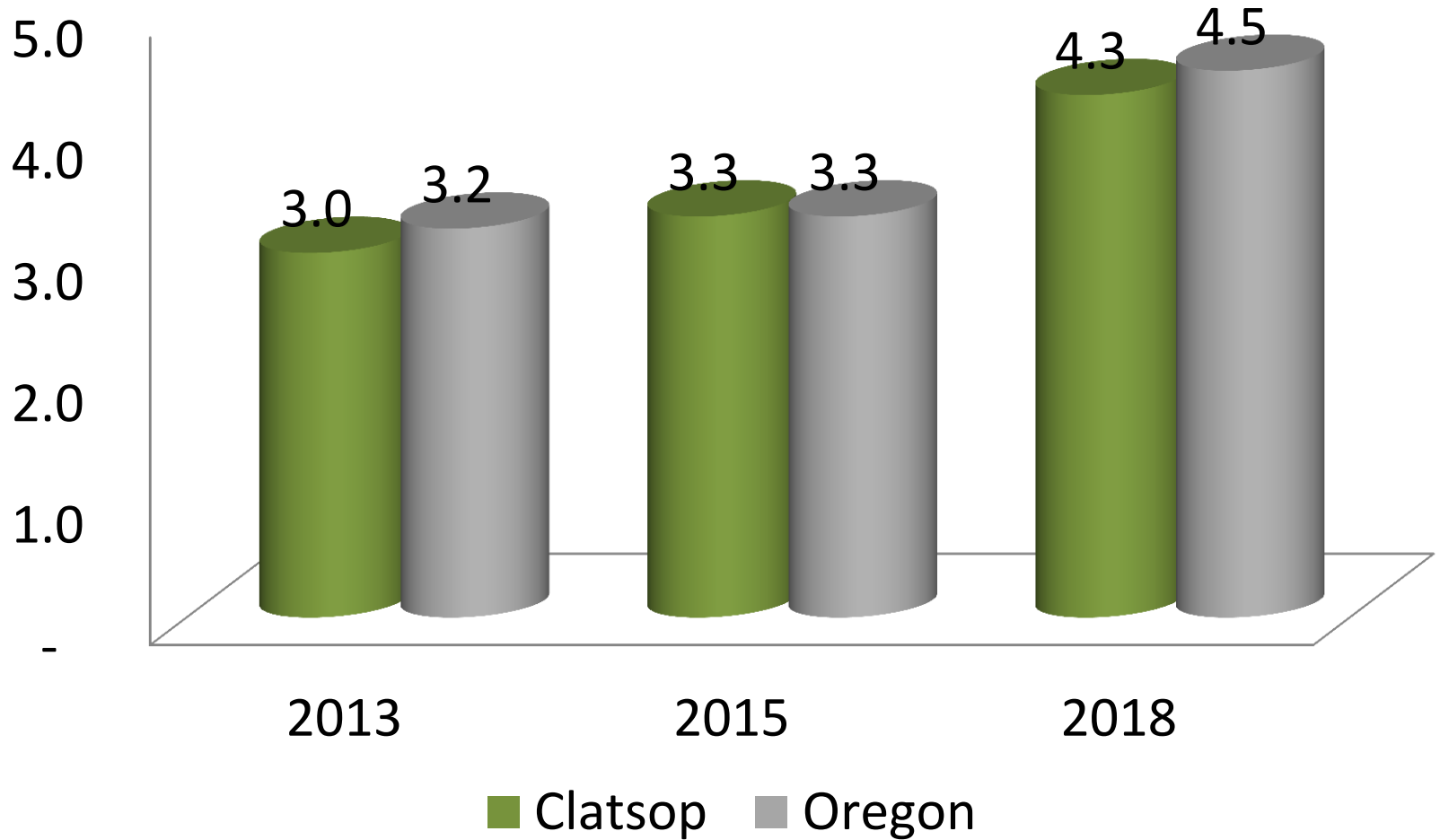
Adult Obesity

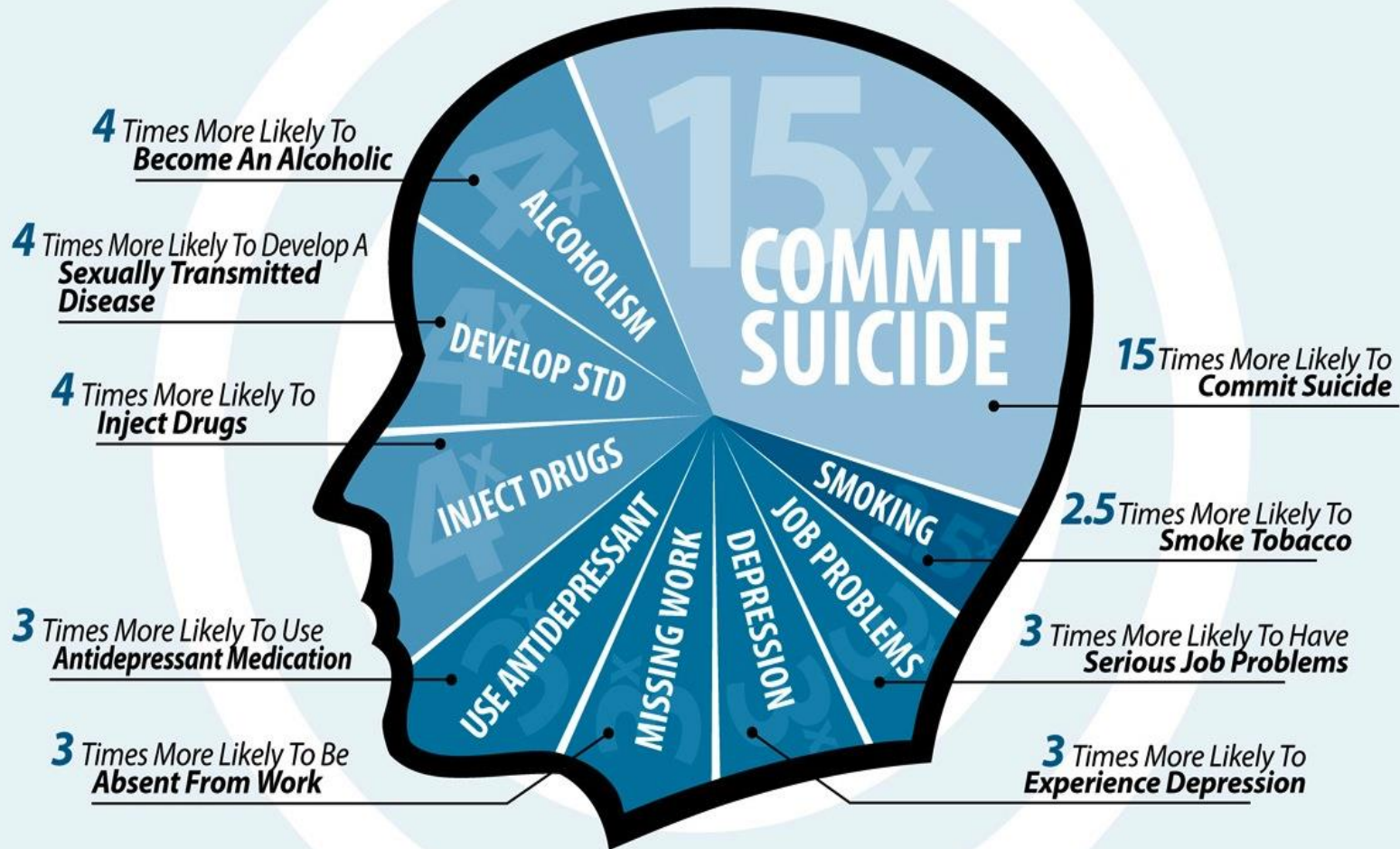

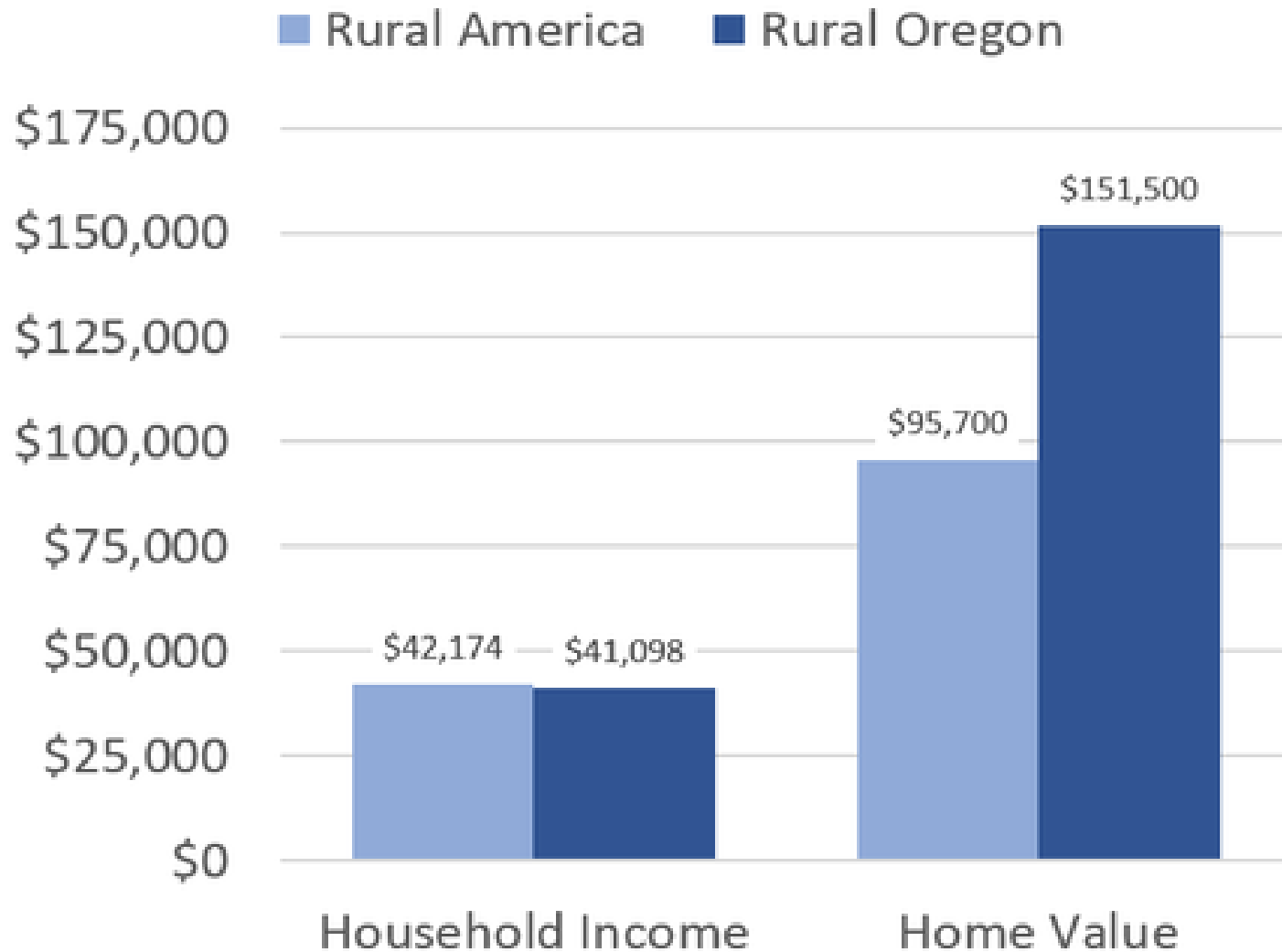

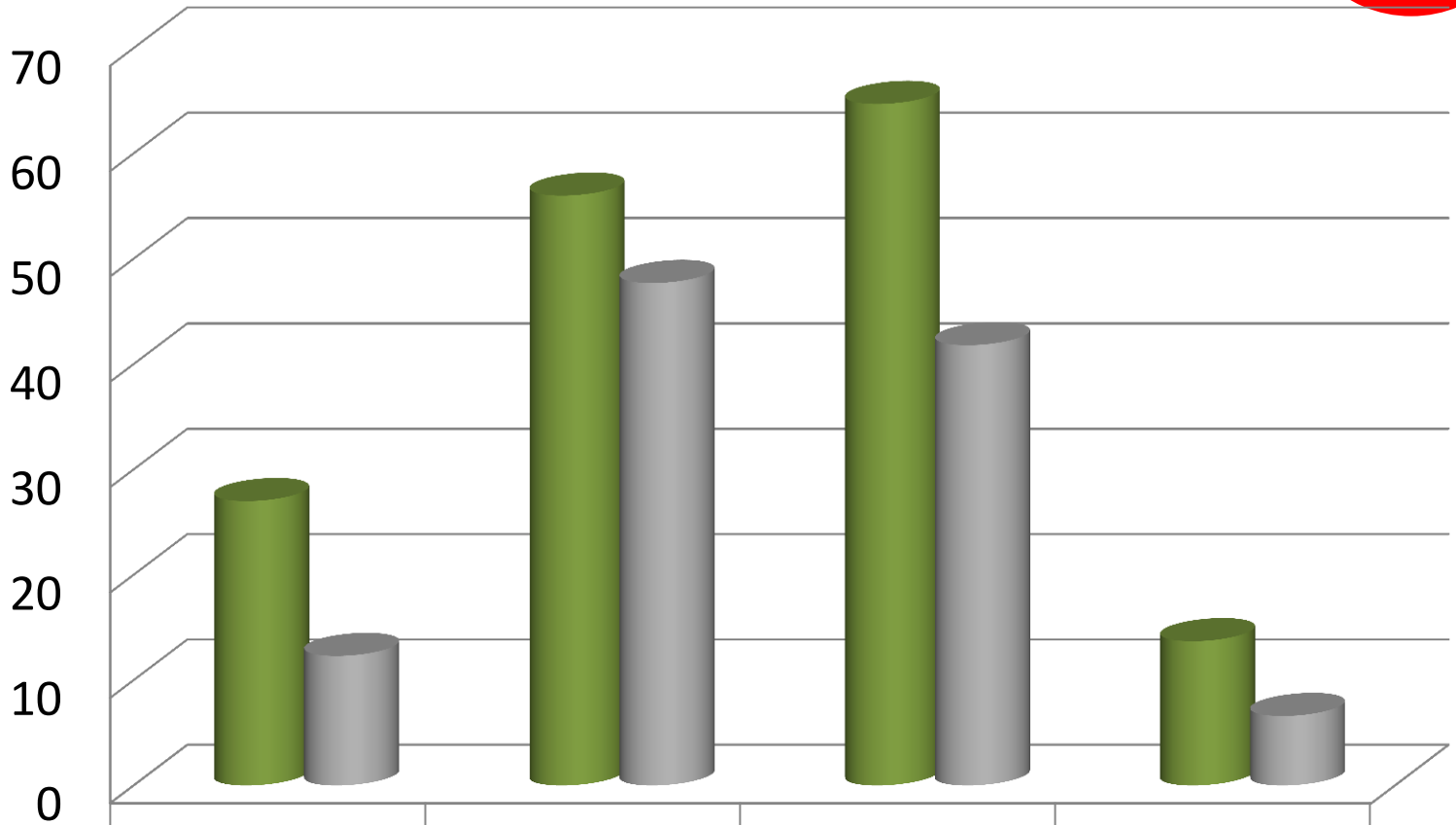
