




War on Drugs

"Did we know we were lying about the drugs? Of course we did"



Pregnant people blamed for outcomes

- Pregnancy is dangerous in the US
 - Birth defects: 3%
 - Miscarriage: 6-20%
 - Maternal Death: 13.8 of every 100,000
- No evidence exists to support these charges
- Creates a new class of crime that can only be committed by people with the capacity for pregnancy

Fetal Assault Laws

- Intent: harsher punishment for hurting a pregnant person
- Reality: Frequently used to prosecute people who are suspected of using illicit drugs or attempting medication abortion
- Charges of murder and decades-long prison sentences are common












HARM REDUCTION in ACTION
